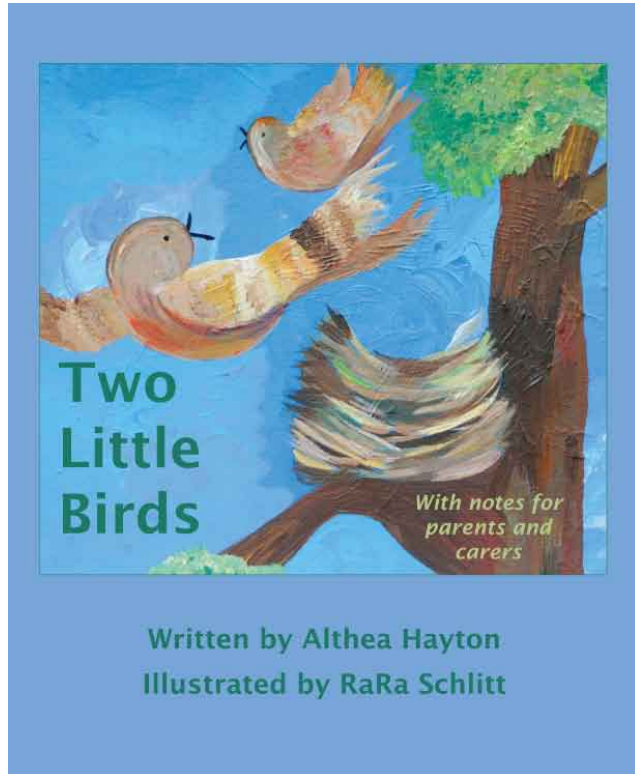

than Beakie.



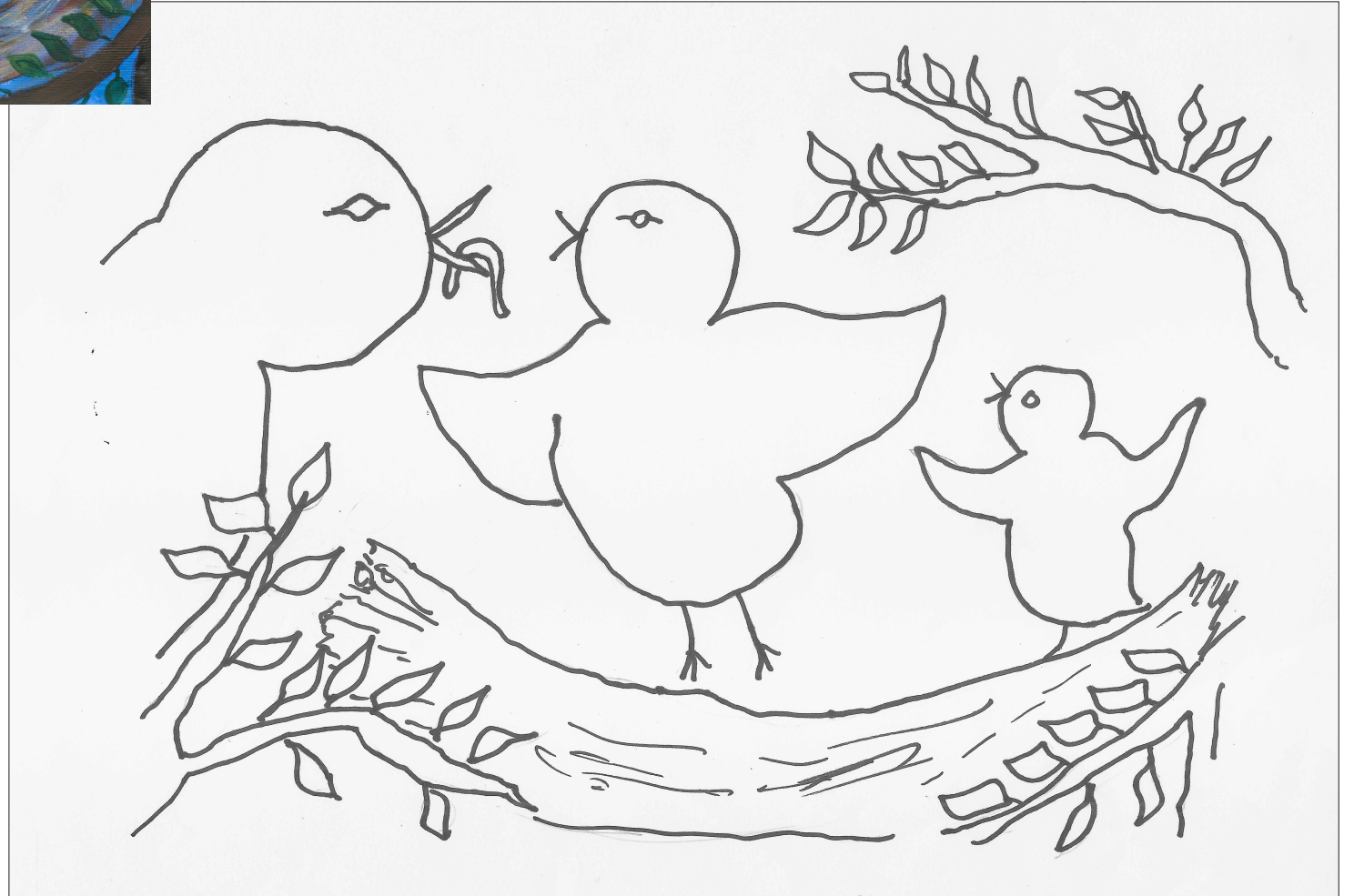


Mummy bird

to see them.



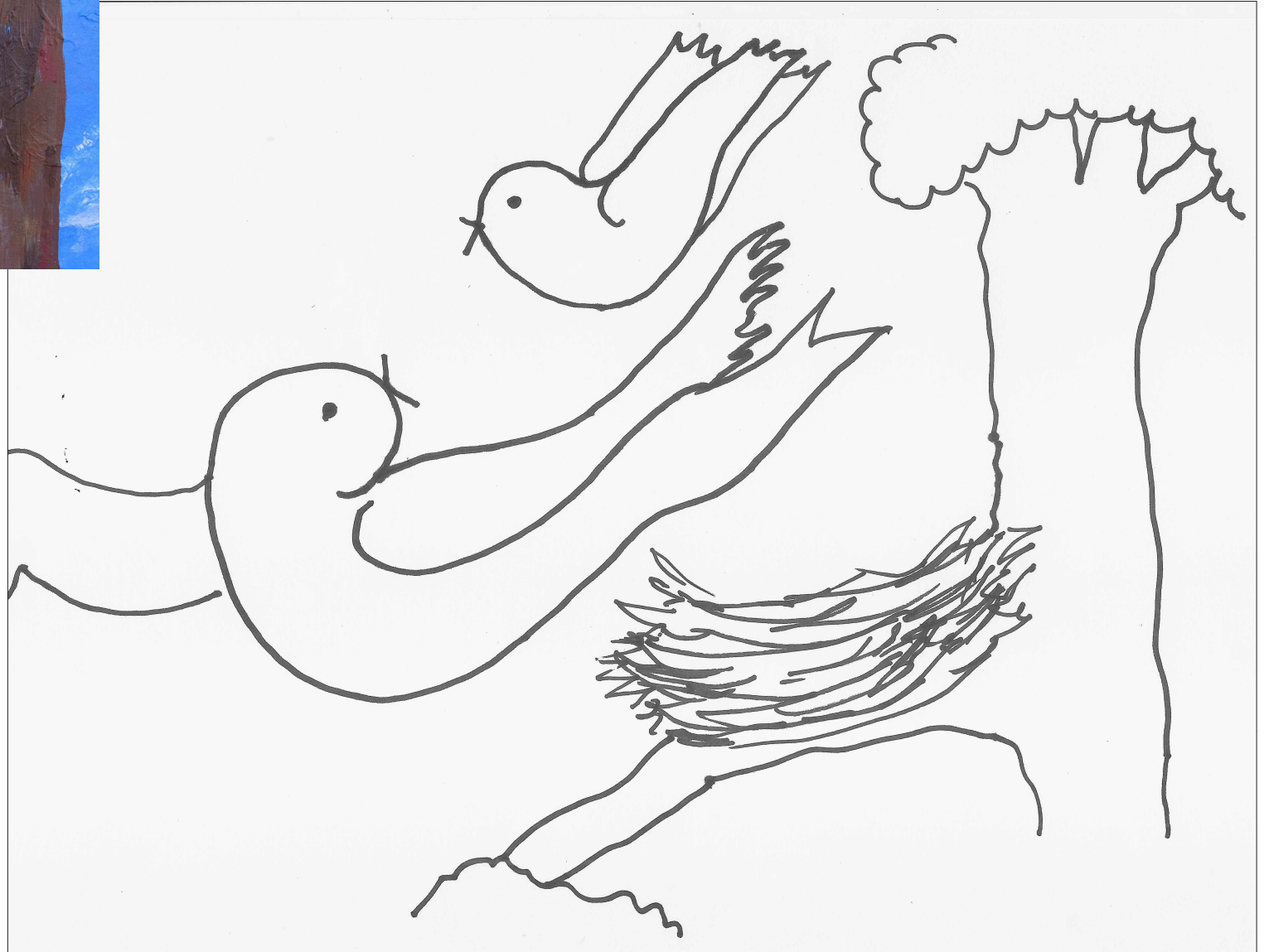


After a while

how to fly.



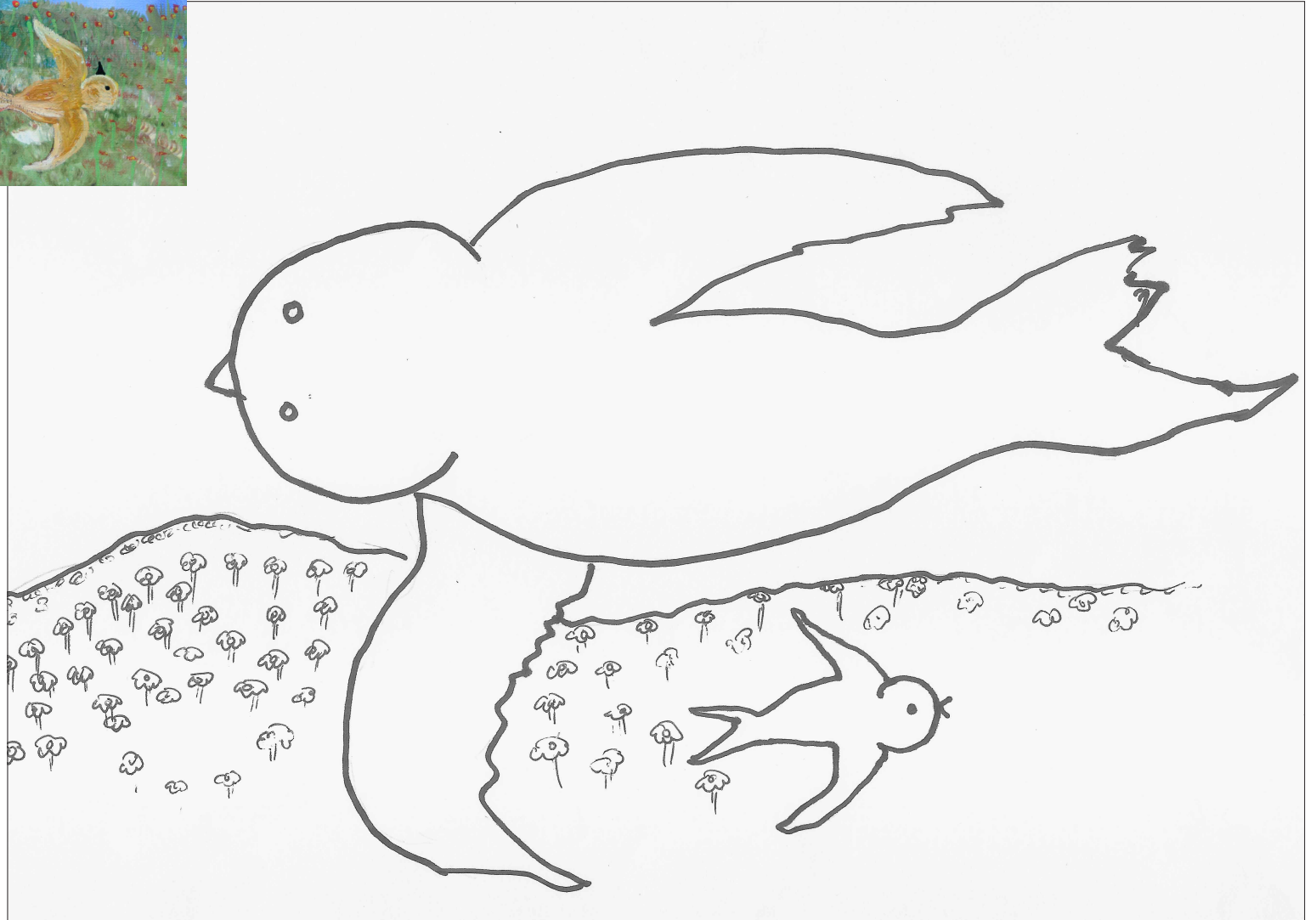


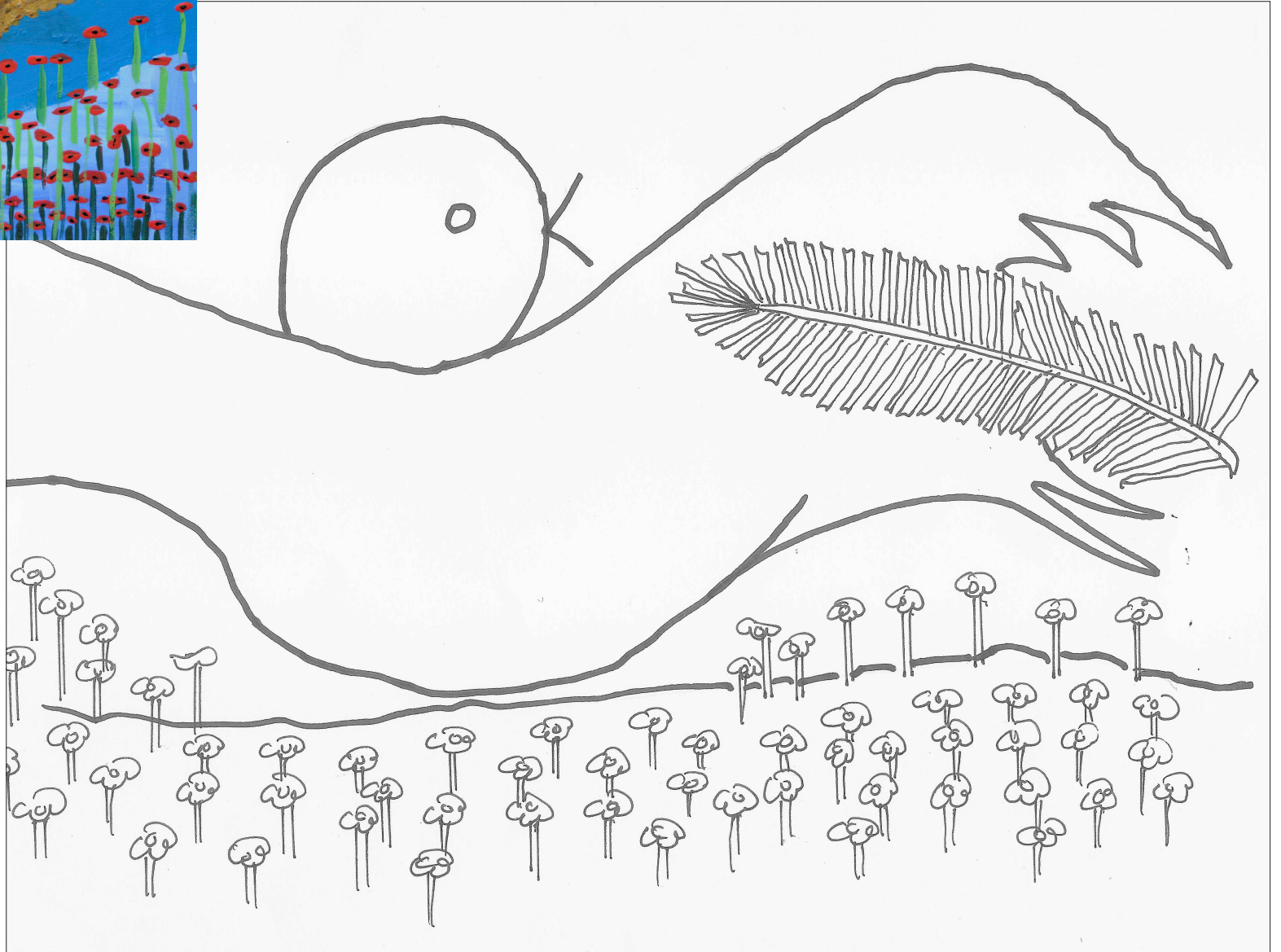
And Beakie

silence.

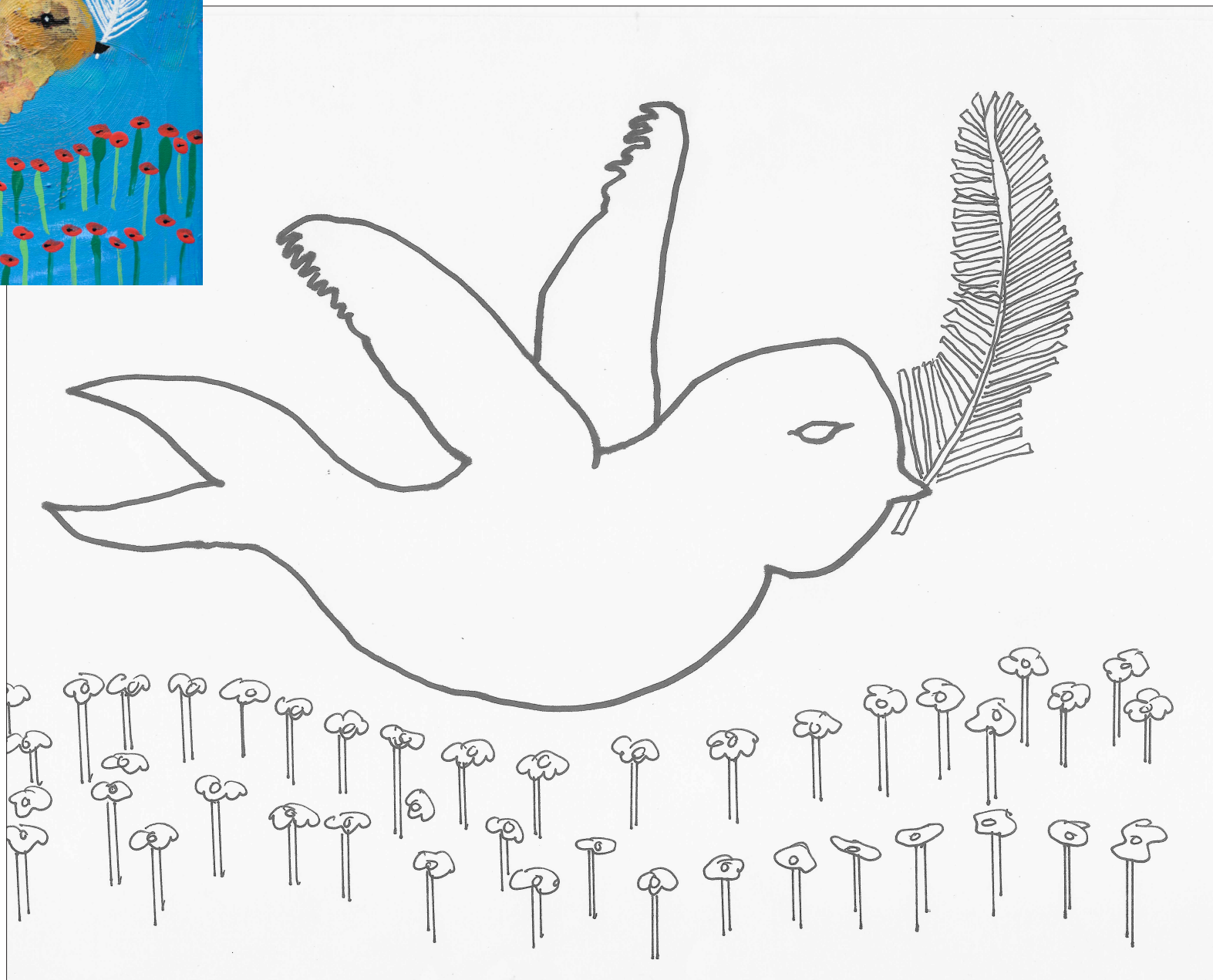




“This is Beakie’s feather,” said Birdy happily.

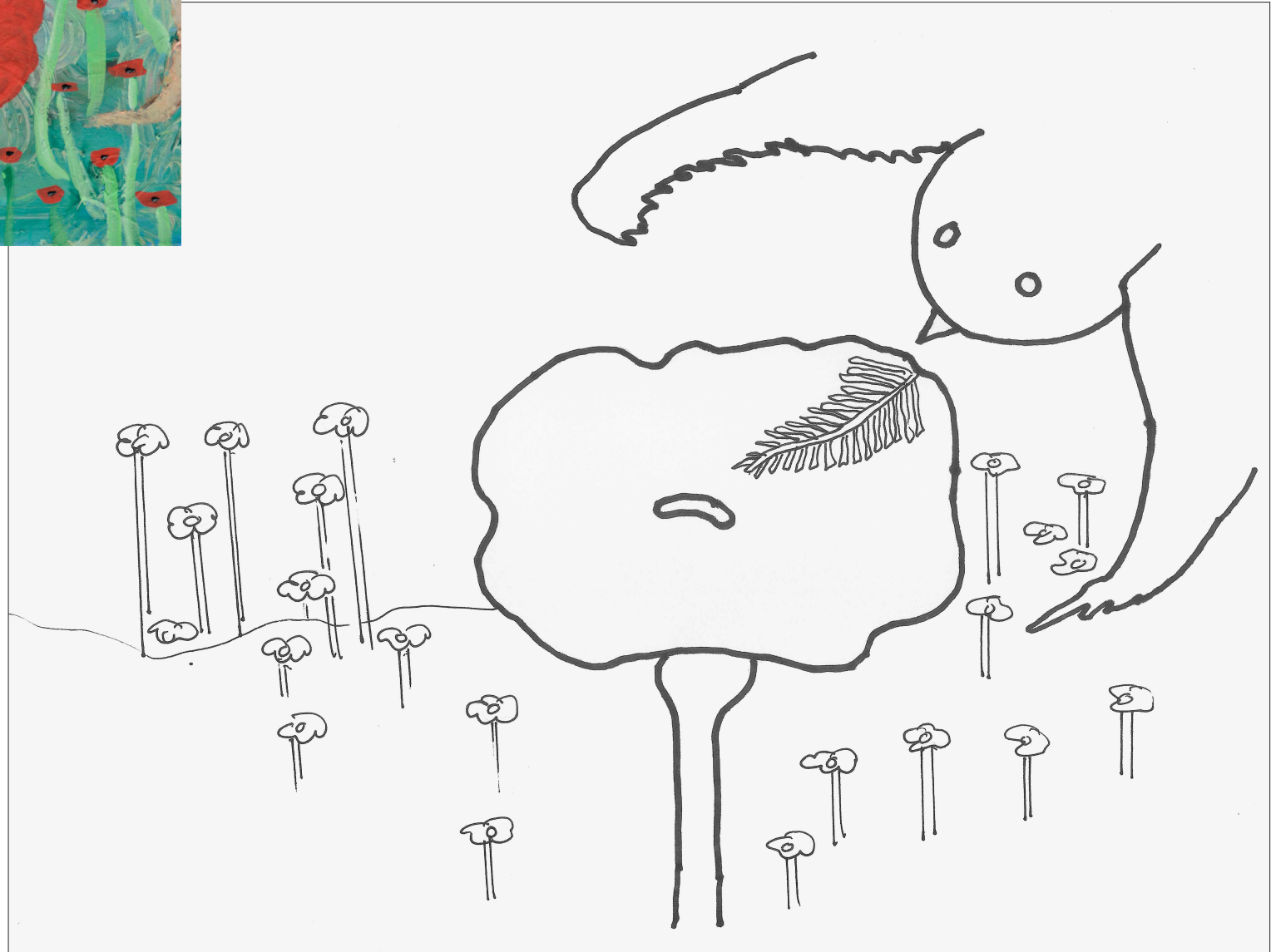


Birdy

trees.



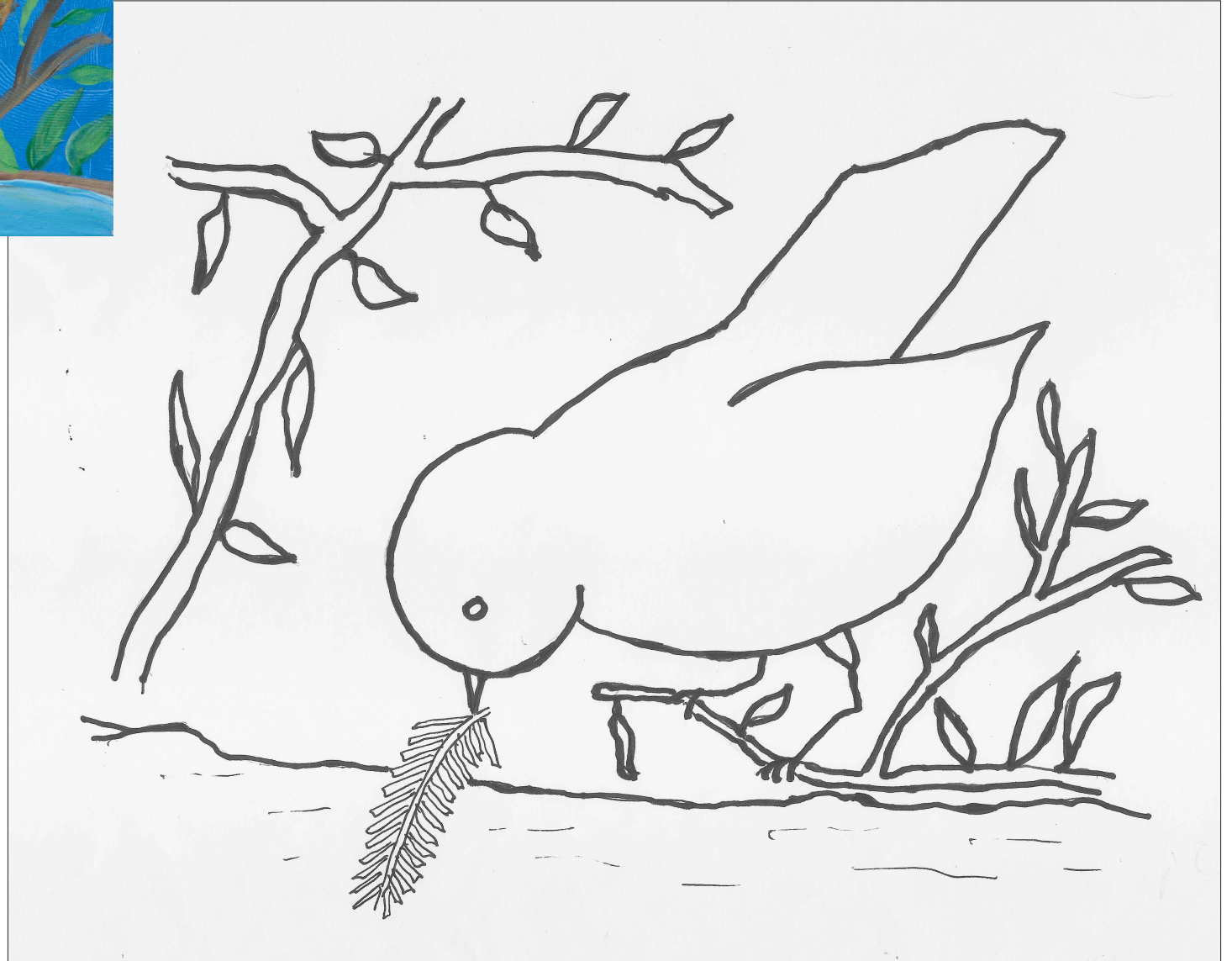


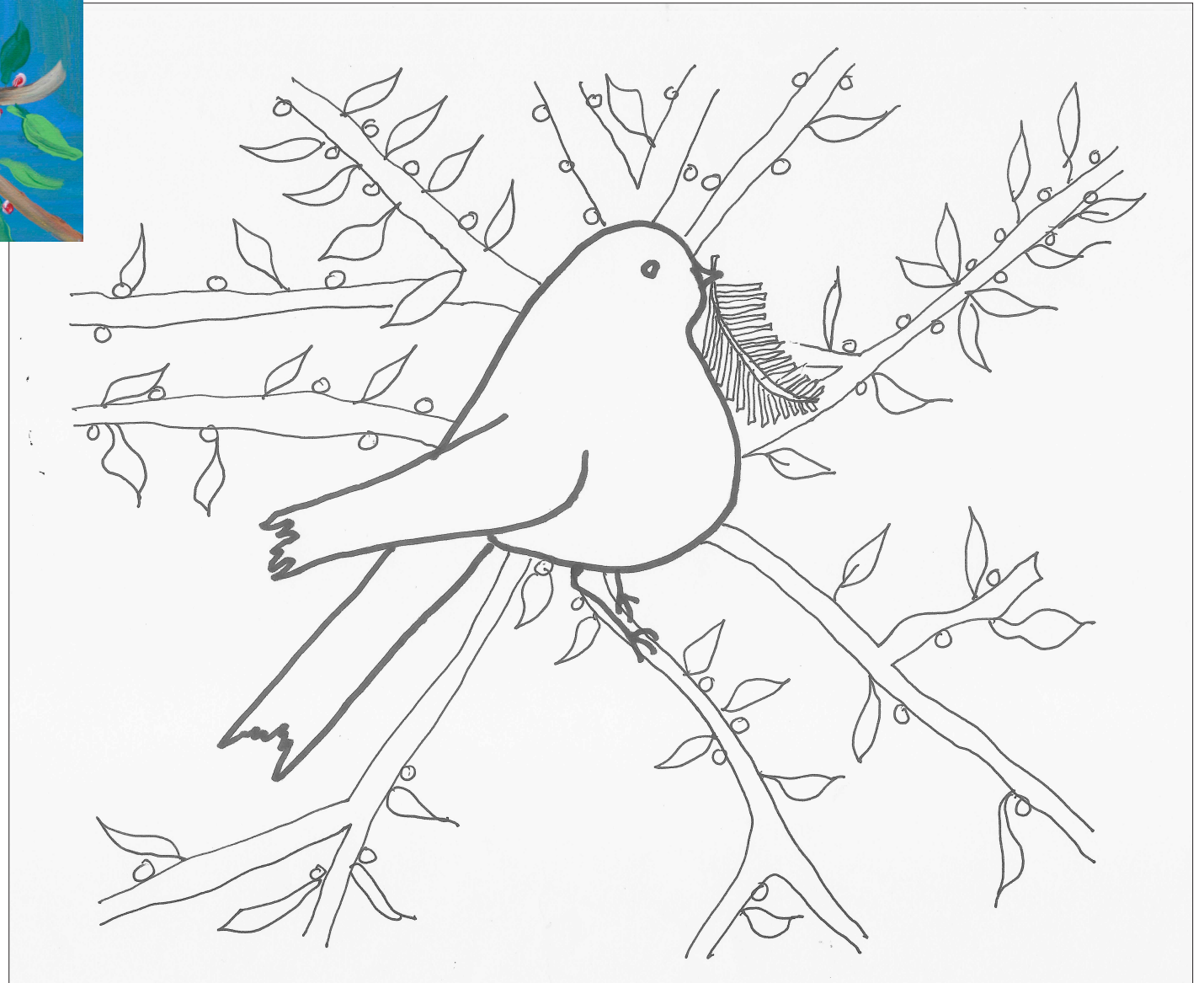
The white feather lay safely in the red poppy flower.

the water.

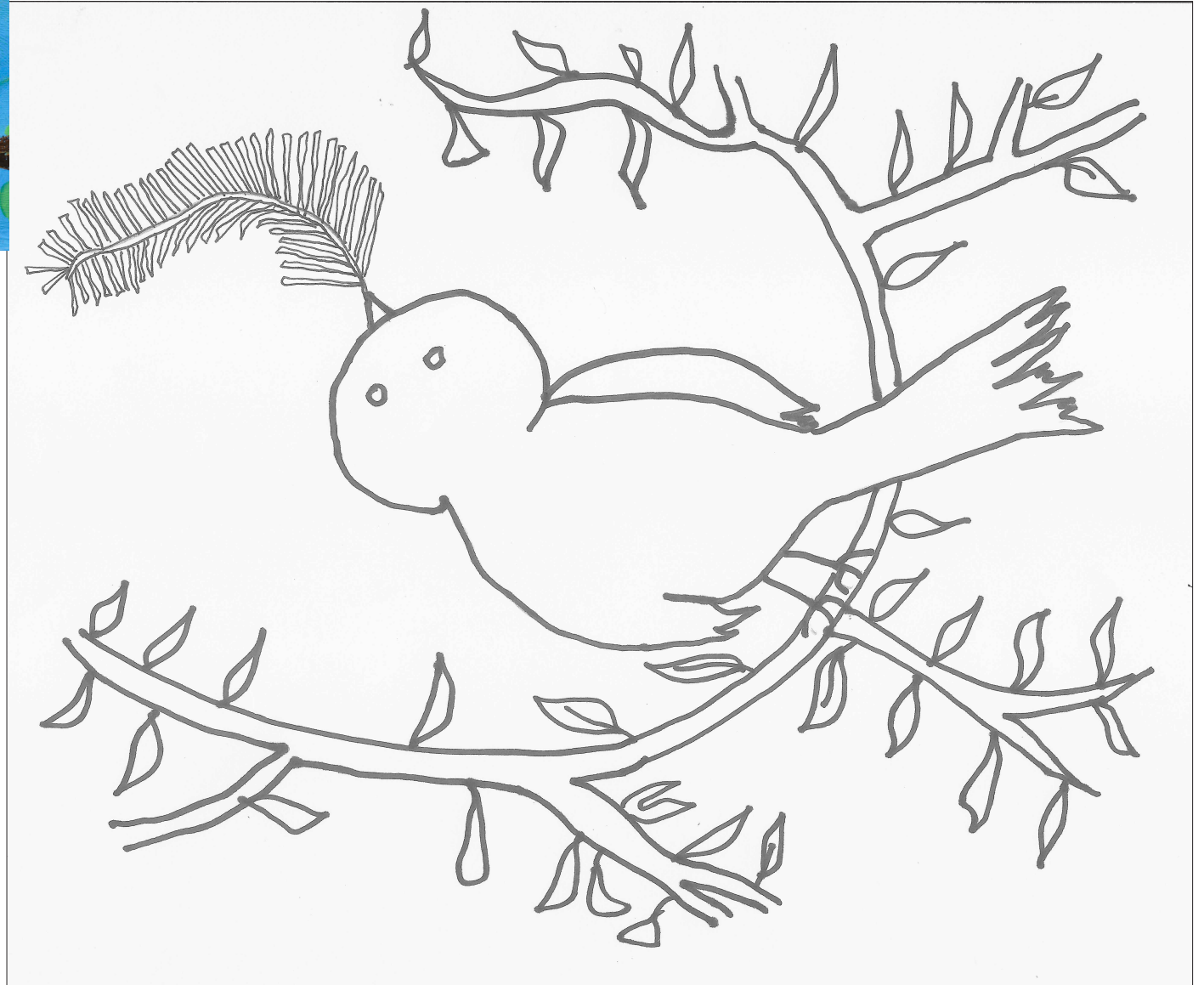


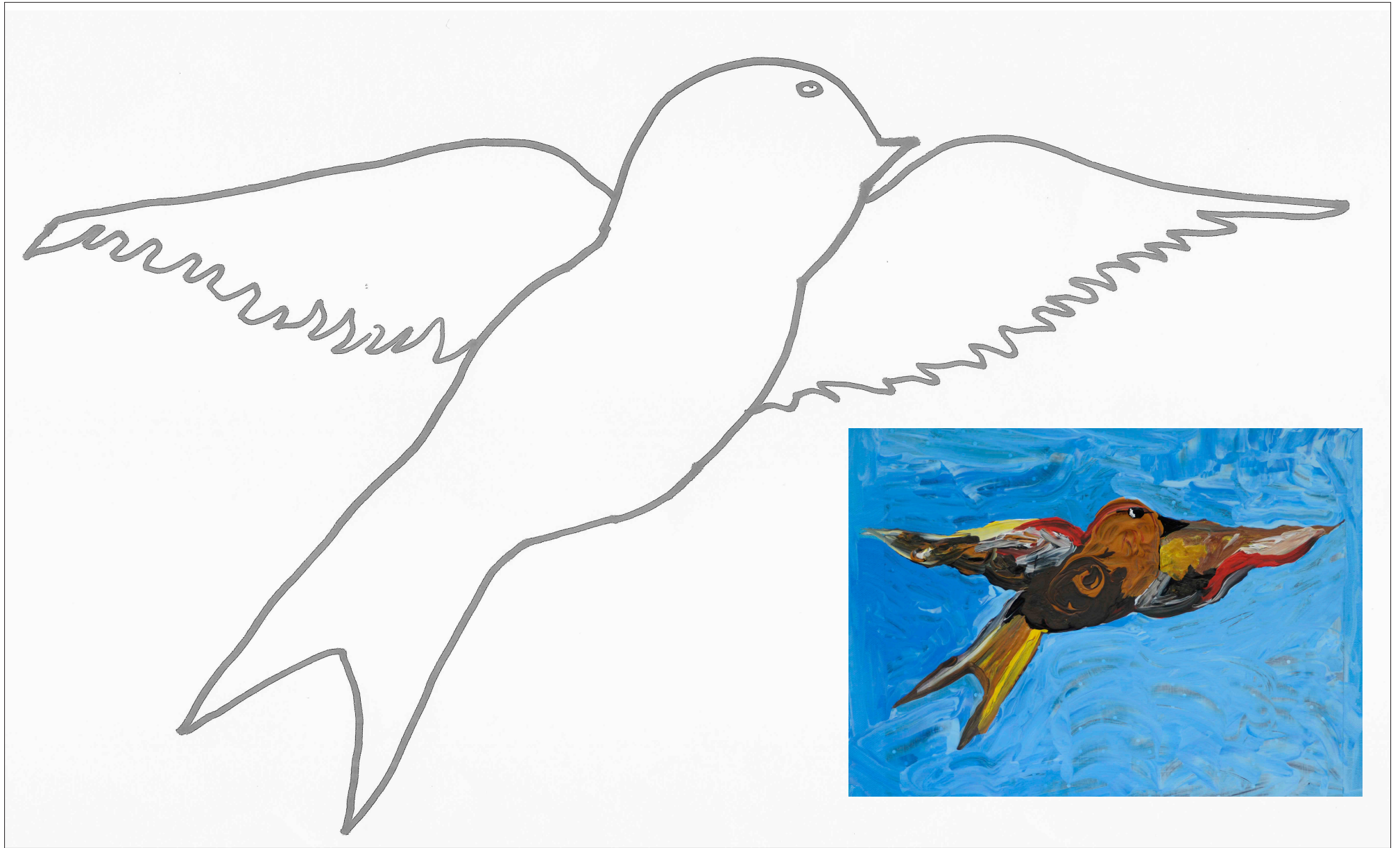


If Beakie wanted to go home, then Birdy had to find a way.
